Dear friends,

The 47th Biennial Conference of the National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP) will be held in Salt Lake City, Utah, on August 11 -14, 2026.

The Biennial Conference is expected to attract more than 250 attendees from all sectors of the poultry industry. One of the key objectives is to allow official delegates from 13 subparts to vote on proposed changes to the provisions contained in Title 9 of the Code of Federal Regulations and the NPIP Program Standards. At the Biennial, technical experts share their opinions on each proposal's scientific merit so that official delegates may then discuss, debate, and vote whether to accept, modify, or reject the original proposals. The outcome of the Biennial Conference affects the entire breeding and commercial poultry industry in the United States and is a critical determinant for the future direction of surveillance and biosecurity programs for Mycoplasma, Salmonella, Avian Influenza, and Newcastle Disease.

The objective of NPIP is to provide a cooperative Industry-State-Federal program through which new or existing diagnostic technology can be effectively applied to the improvement of poultry and poultry products by controlling or eliminating specific poultry diseases. The continued support from industry, state poultry federations, and allied partners is essential to the collaborative nature of the program. This year's conference is expected to provide attendees with valuable opportunities for fellowship and engagement through a welcome reception and networking breaks throughout the meeting.
