We anticipate sharing very soon the new dates selected for the 2021 Biennial Conference and hope you plan to join us. For anyone who has already registered for the 2020 August Biennial Conference in Providence, RI, please review the instructions below:

Registration Guidance:

- ✓ The NPIP Registration Website is now closed. All registration fees already paid to California Poultry Federation will be credited and carried over for your attendance at the 2021 Biennial Conference. No further action is required as you are considered registered for the 2021 Biennial Conference.
- ✓ If you prefer a refund of registration fees paid for 2020, please respond to Sandy Pohl (<u>sandy@cpif.org</u>) and copy Penny Kesler (<u>Penny.E.Kesler@usda.gov</u>) no later than June 30, 2020. Your refund will be issued within 30 days.

Hotel and Travel Guidance:

- ✓ No further action is needed at this time if you have reserved a room at the Omni Providence Hotel through the NPIP's reserved room block. The Omni has canceled the block; you will not be charged for your reservation. If you booked your hotel outside the NPIP room block, you will need to contact Omni Hotels & Resorts to cancel.
